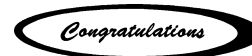

JULY 13TH – 15TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Today's Gospel gives opportunity to reflect upon the Parable of the Sower in light of vocations and vocation awareness. The seed that is being spread is that of Faith – as each priest or religious preaches the Word of God and the Church's teachings it is Faith that is spread through the world.
