THE YEAR OF SAINT PAUL

This year has been proclaimed “The Pauline Year” by Pope Benedict XVI on the 2,000th anniversary of the birth of Saint Paul, the Apostle. During this year, beginning on June 28th, and continuing through June 29th of 2009, the Holy Father has granted a *Plenary Indulgence* to all the faithful who attend public functions of worship. St. Henry’s Church has been designated as one of those “places.” You might ask yourselves what a Plenary Indulgence is. The United States Catholic Catechism for Adults tell us, “Every sin has consequences. It disrupts our communion with God and the Church, weakens our ability to resist temptation and hurt others. The necessity of healing these consequences, once the sin itself has been forgiven, is called temporal punishment. Because of the fullness of redemption obtained for us by Christ, the Church attaches to certain prayers and actions an *indulgence* or pardon, that is, the full or partial remission of temporal punishment due to sin. Christ, acting through the Church, brings about the healing of the consequences of sin when an individual uses such a prayer or engages in such an action.”

HOW CAN ONE GAIN PLENARY INDULGENCE?

A Plenary Indulgence may be gained once a day under the usual conditions (i.e., Sacramental Confession, Eucharistic Communion and prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father). During this year of St. Paul: if one participates in a religious function or in a pious exercise held publicly in honor of St. Paul:

a) On the days of the solemn opening and closing of the Pauline Year (the evening of June 28th into the day of June 29th) in any place of worship; b) On other days determined by the Archbishop in holy places named for Saint Paul or in other places designated by the same Ordinary – in Bayonne’s case, the Church of Saint Henry; c) Concluding with the recitation of the “Our Father”, the “Apostles Creed” or the Nicene Creed” and an invocation of the Blessed Virgin Mary and Saint Paul linking such acts of devotion to the memory of the Prince of Apostles, Saint Peter.
